PROJECT OVERVIEW

The law firm was founded more than 50 years ago, initially specialising in **corporate law** and have since expanded into other areas such as **business reorganisation** and **bankruptcy**. Their vast range of services means you'll get excellent, all-round experience.

As with any law placement, the work you'll be involved with will vary according to your own abilities and to what the company requires from you at the time you're there. Your office work will vary from day to day, case to case and intern to intern but you are likely to be involved in case studies and have the opportunity to visit the law courts.

At the law firm you will be allocated a supervisor who will be responsible for your day to day work. The staff are really friendly and full of energy and most of them speak English. You'll work alongside 20 qualified lawyers in a large open-plan office in the heart of Buenos Aires.

Office work will vary from day to day and according to the cases they are working on at the time of your internship but will most likely include:

- Study cases
- Making drafts
- Comparative analysis of international laws
- Involvement in institutional contracts, commercial contracts, constitution of Companies abroad
- Involvement in Share holders agreements
- Visit the courts and have the chance to observe hearings and trials

Working in this Law firm will give you the opportunity to gain experience in the day-to-day running of a law practice. As with any law placement, the work you'll be involved with will vary according to your own abilities and attitude, and to what the company requires from you at the time you're there.

Exactly what your office work will involve will vary from day to day, case to case and intern to intern. The all-round exposure you will gain will give you an extraordinary insight into Argentine law.

Your working hours are likely to be 10am – 3pm Monday to Friday.

Please note that you need to be pro-active on this project and ask lots of questions!



ACCOMMODATION

There are two choices for accommodation in Buenos Aires. You can choose to stay in a hostel where you will meet up with other travellers or for a more cultural experience you can choose to stay with a local family.

The hostel is located in the central district just a 15 minutes walk from the congress in one direction and Casa Rosa in the other. There are many shops, supermarkets, restaurants and banks nearby and just a few minutes walk from the nearest metro station.

This is a privately run, independent hostel for backpackers and comprises basic but clean facilities.

Food: You'll be given an allowance for your meals (breakfast and dinner, lunch is excluded projects in Buenos Aires).

HOST FAMILY: For a more cultural experience you can choose to be accommodated with a local family. This allows you to get a better understanding of the culture of Argentina and you will be fluent in Spanish in no time! Basic/intermediate Spanish is required to stay with a Host Family. Please note that if you'd prefer to live with a host family, there is an additional supplement.

These families have been visited and vetted by Travellers and provide comfortable, warm and safe living surroundings. You'll most likely have access to TV/DVD and communal dining room. This is an excellent way to improve your Spanish too!

Food: Breakfast and dinner will be provided by your host family.
